



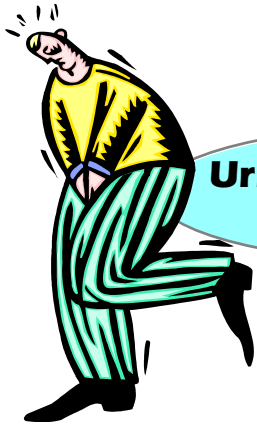

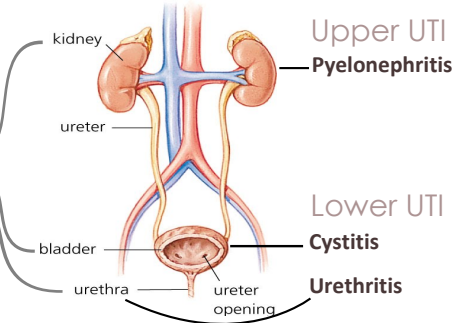
Uncomplicated

Asymptomatic Bacteruria (ASB)

7-day course

Avoid?

Symptomatic cystitis in pregnancy

UTI & Sexual Intercourse

Post-coital antibiotic prophylaxis

A single nightly dose of:

Continuously for 6 months

Recurrent UTI

Postcoital prophylaxis
